I was mainly involved in the practical work conducting the 3-year follow-up, which included child examinations, parent interviews, parent contact and data entering.

SKOT-III was a part of work package 2; “early life intervention”, in the research programme "Governing Obesity" at UCPH, and in this interdisciplinary group of scientists, results from SKOT-III were continuously presented and discussed.
